# WHAT DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE?

Our team have planned and designed this tour based on years of adventure riding, travel experience and contacts throughout New Zealand. The routes, sights, and experiences on this tour have been selected to showcase a broad selection of what the South Island has to offer. We have taken all the hard work out of organising such an epic tour, so you can truly sit back in the saddle and enjoy the Adventure!

- Motorcycle Your choice of KTM adventure motorcycle from our fleet (subject to availability). We operate KTM 890, 790, 690 and 390 models to suit different rider abilities and preferences. See the motorcycle models and pricing pages.
- **Motorcycle fuel** All the fuel (petrol) for your bike is covered in the tour package cost. The tour will stop for fuel frequently with no chance of you running out.
- Planned Routes Pre-ridden routes, selecting some of the best adventure riding routes the South has to offer.
- Tour Guides Experienced adventure motorcycle tour guides who have been there and done it before. A riding guide will lead the tour so there is no chance of getting lost. For groups of 6 or more there will also be a second riding guide running at the rear in support to ensure everyone is on track and no one gets left behind. Tap into their local knowledge and maybe even pick up some adventure riding tips along the way.
- **Pre-Ride Briefings** We provide a full ride and safety briefing prior to our tour departure, and before each days riding. Briefings detail the route, break locations, any hazards or harder sections, sight-seeing opportunities, tourist and photo opportunities, and any optional extra riding sections available for when time allows.
- **Breakfast** Breakfast is provided daily during the tour. Other meals including lunches and dinners are at the individuals own expense. We stop frequently for refreshment and lunch breaks during each day.
- GPS Routes Garmin Zumo XT GPS units are supplied on all bikes with daily routes preloaded.
- Accommodation At the end of each day during the tour, rest easy in the knowledge that your accommodation is taken care of. With a range of different accommodation including Hotels and Motels depending on our location for the night. Standard accommodation is twin share. If you are a single rider you will be allocated a ½ twin share room, the room will be shared with another tour participant of the same sex. A single room option is available at additional cost. Please advise after booking if you require the single room option.
- **Mechanical Assistance** In the rare event that you have a mechanical issue with the bike e.g. flat tyre, our guides will be on hand to fix the problem, or arrange assistance for any major mechanical failures.
- Medical Assistance All our tour guides and support staff hold formal First Aid training qualifications and are there
  to assist with any medical issues or accidents. For more serious medical events our guides also carry emergency
  locator and communication devices for fast response from New Zealand Emergency Services.
- T-Shirt Been there, done that and got the T-Shirt! An Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Tour T-Shirt is included.

#### ITINERARY

Pre Tour Arrival – It is recommended that participants arrange to be in Christchurch on the day before the tour, as Day 1 has an early 8:00am start at the Ultimate Adventure Moto depot. Unfortunately we are unable to provide airport transfers or pickups on the morning of Day 1 due to a busy morning greeting guests, conducting briefings and getting organised for the tour departure. Therefore participants need to make their own way to Ultimate Adventure Moto depot by 8:00am on Day 1.

Our Day 1 pre-tour briefing includes;

- Welcome & Introduction staff introduction & participants meet and greet, complimentary tea/coffee
- Tour check-in final paperwork and security deposit processing
- Tour Description outlining the route and some of the sights and activities
- Riding in New Zealand brief road rules, conditions, hazards and what to expect
- Health & safety briefing what to do in case of any emergencies.
- Gear Check we will check all riders to ensure suitable safe riding gear is being worn
- Bike handover run over bike and GPS setup and functions

After the pre-tour briefing we will pack our paniers and bags, gear up and get ready for the first days ride to Blenheim in the stunning Marlborough wine region!

# ROUTE DESCRIPTION

#### Day 1 - Christchurch to Blenheim - 386km

Leaving Christchurch and heading North via some nice flowing highways before the first taste of gravel, climbing and twisting over a back country mountain range through beautiful farmland. A stop for lunch then and pushing on over a tight twisting highway road to the rugged Kaikoura coastline with its famous surf breaks and ocean wildlife featuring seals, dolphins and whales. One last cruise up the fabulous coastline to Blenheim completes day one with a great mixture of back country gravel and beautiful twisting coastal highways.

#### Day 2 – Blenheim to Hanmer Springs – 316km

From Blenheim the day takes us south to Hanmer, but first a morning loop onto some magnificent twisty gravel and sealed roads around numerous picturesque costal bays, an awesome place to get your corner fix and some amazing photos. Back on the highway for a short ride back thru Blenheim and out the other side through a gravel pass and into an iconic back-country valley which cuts through the backbone of the South Island and home to New Zealand's largest farming station. Prepare to be awestruck by the expansive high country landscapes, towering mountains and vast grassy plains that surround you. This rewarding gravel ride is on every Kiwi adventure riders bucket list, offering a true sense of back country adventure. Finishing the day ion Hanmer Springs where you can soak the evening away and sooth your muscles in the famous thermal hot pools.



#### Day 3 – Hanmer Springs to Westport – 290km

The third day begins by conquering another famous and remote back-country valley road, a rugged and thrilling route that cuts through the heart of the South Island's sub alpine landscape. Brace yourself for jaw-dropping views as you navigate through steep mountain passes, ancient beech forests, and remote river valleys. This road offers an adrenaline-pumping experience, with its challenging terrain and breathtaking vistas that will leave you in awe at every turn. As you exit this valley you will reach a tranquil alpine village nestled by the shores of stunning lake. Take a moment to soak in the serenity and enjoy the picturesque surroundings. Gear up for the next leg of your adventure as you twist and turn along winding mountain roads, with rugged cliffs, dense forests, and cascading waterfalls. The days journey culminates in Westport, a vibrant coastal town known for its dramatic coastline and impressive surf breaks. For those who just can't get enough adventure there is an optional 50km return trip up a mountain to the old ruins of a historic mining settlement.

#### Day 4 – Westport to Franz Josef – 352km

Departing south along one of New Zealand's most amazing coastal highway roads, be treated by the breathtaking rugged coastline and amazing layered rock formations at Punankaiki. Towering mountains and dense native forests provide a dramatic backdrop as the route passes by the shores of a lake nestled in the countryside before continuing back along the West Coast coastline and its major towns. The road continues south following the snow capped peaks of the southern alps and rushing rivers with plenty of scenic bridge crossings before arriving at Franz Josef Glacier, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where you can witness the awe-inspiring icy expanse up close.

#### Day 5 - Franz Josef to Queenstown - 357km

A highway transition day departing Franz and heading south via the West Coast and dense native bush into the Haast Pass with a stop at a fantastic waterfall before arriving at the first of the stunning southern lakes and the beautiful lakeside town of Wanaka where we stop for lunch. From here is through the Cardrona Valley with its famous historic pub, then over the stunning Crown Range and zig zag road down to Arrowtown before arriving in the tourist mecca of Queenstown. For the adventurous and if time allows head into the historic skippers canyon for an amazing backcountry gravel excursion.


#### Day 6 – Queenstown to Alexandra – 287km

Todays route winds down the side of the stunning Lake Wakatipu into the beautiful Southland countryside where we turn and enter a back-country experience not to be missed. Climbing steeply up a switchback road to 1100m then traversing a famous and epic valley which includes a good section of 4WD track with creek and river crossings to keep the adrenaline pumping! Some more sweeping gravel roads and a power pylon track lead us past one of NZ's largest hydro dams. A small highway section past Cromwell were we stop for lunch then that takes the tour through a remote farming valley featuring high country farm land with plenty of farm gates and epic views. Dropping out of the valley and some more great open flowing gravel takes us back to Alexandra to reminisce on an epic day of back-country riding.

#### Day 7 – Alexandra to Otematata – 415km

Shortly after Alexandra it's a steep climb to over 1600m on a 4WD track onto an elevated mountain range where a unique rock Obelix monolith stares out over the valley below. Descending back down into the valley below to experience driving over another great hydro dam the route then leads us back-country again along a famous historic wagon route from gold mining days long past. A lunch stop back in civilisation before more epic gravel action thru rolling farmland before arriving at Kyeburn Diggings and the historic Danseys Pass Hotel where it's worth the stop for a coffee or refreshment. Danseys Pass is next with plenty of awesome sweeping gravel corners. Out onto the highway again takes us to Otematata for the night where we will chill out, tell some tales over a meal and a drink at the local pub.







# Day 8 - Otematata to Methven - 321km

Two options for the trip back to Christchurch which will be decided on the day depending on weather conditions and river levels. Either a gravel blast up three awesome mountain passes, or over another hydro dam and a very special high country Merino sheep station and rocky gravel riverbed tracks onto the glacial lakes of Pukaki and Tekapo, where you can get majestic views of Aoraki Mount Cook and the Southern Alps. At a stop for lunch at a famous bakery or any of the other local cafes to refuel the body. After lunch is on the inland scenic highway route to the ski resort village of Methven.

#### Day 9 – Methven to Christchurch – 255km

Heading across a single lane highway bridge you will get amazing views of the Rakaia Gorge and its impressive river system, before more deserted gravel roads lead the tour past two remote lakes and over a mountain pass to another amazing braided river system. A twisting and winding gravel hill climb over to a remote North Canterbury farming valley will fill in the early afternoon with one last river to navigate and test your well developed water crossing skills. A half an hour gentle highway ride will bring the tour back to the garden city of Christchurch where you can relax in the pool at the hotel or enjoy some of the local sights.



# Day 10 - Christchurch to Christchurch - 275km

The final day is a scenic loop around the beautiful Banks Peninsula. From the city heading straight up to the summit road overlooking Christchurch and the Canterbury Plains you we be amazed by the expansive views. The route then circumnavigates this impressive peninsula, winding its way around, up and over the many harbours and bays that form this unique landscape. Plenty of twisting gravel roads and winding tar seal sections link all these epic harbours in a day of riding that will hone your cornering skills and excite your senses with amazing scenery. Arriving back in Christchurch in the mid afternoon you will feel a sense of great accomplishment having navigated your way around the "best of the best" adventure riding New Zealand has to offer.

# **PREREQUISITES**

The South Island Back-Country Adventure Tour is a back country adventure motorcycle ride focussing on gravel roads and 4WD tracks with some technical sections including rough terrain, steep climbs and descents, steep drop offs, and multiple water crossings. The tour is therefore designed for intermediate ability riders and above with gravel road riding experience. THE SOUTHERN PASSES TOUR IS NOT SUITABLE FOR BEGINNER RIDERS.

Tour participants must:

- Have a motorcycle licence valid for riding in New Zealand, and
- Be a minimum of 25 years old, and
- Have some off-road or gravel riding experience, and
- Be comfortable riding in rough, bumpy, narrow, and steep terrain, and
- Be able to ride standing up on motorcycle footpegs including over small obstacles

While our experienced guides can assist riders through more difficult sections if required, the guides are not there to instruct or help inexperienced riders to complete the tour. Beginner and inexperienced riders may slow the group progress during the tour and cause delays and frustration for other participants. If you have any doubt about the rider skill level required please contact us to discuss <u>before</u> booking.

### WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

While we provide most things you need for the 5 day tour we can't supply absolutely everything, particularly personal items. You will need to bring with you the following items:

- Personal Clothing At the end of each days riding you will want to change out of your riding gear into something a
  little more comfortable. Please bring with you changes of clothes for 5 days of travel. New Zealand has very
  changeable weather so make sure you have packed some warmer clothing if it gets cool. Some destinations will
  have a laundry service or laundry available for you to do your own clothes washing if required.
- Motorcycle Riding Gear It is best if you bring your own riding gear to ensure accurate fit and comfort. We do
  have a selection of riding gear for hire at additional cost however for your own comfort we suggest you bring your
  own gear. We do not hire boots. We suggest bringing the following as a minimum:

# **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

### PAYMENT POLICY

#### **Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Ltd Payment Policy**

- A non-refundable deposit of NZD\$2,000 is required to secure your place on the tour and confirm your motorcycle selection from available models.
- Deposit payments are to be made by Credit Card via the online booking system on our website www.ultimateadventuremoto.co.nz/adv-tours. All deposits are non-refundable.
- An invoice will be emailed to you for the outstanding balance with full payment due 60 days before the tour departure. Payment can be made via bank transfer Direct Credit or Credit Card. Invoice payments via credit card will incur a 2.9% surcharge.
- If Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Ltd has not received the final balance payment within 60 days before the start of the tour, the deposit will be forfeited and the booking cancelled.
- A Bond of NZD\$2,500 is required per motorcycle hire at the commencement of the tour. (See Insurance terms and conditions below.)
- All prices shown are in New Zealand Dollars (\$NZD)
- All prices include New Zealand Government Goods and Services Tax (GST) of 15%

#### CANCELLATION POLICY

#### PARTICIPANT CANCELLATION

A participant may withdraw from the tour at any time by notifying Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Ltd in writing via email or dated letter. In case of withdrawal, a cancellation fee calculated by reference to the total tour fee is payable as follows:

- More than 60 days before the tour start date: Loss of NZD\$2,000 non-refundable deposit.
- **60-30 days before the tour start date**: 50% of the total tour cost.
- **0-29 days before the tour start date:** 100% of the total tour cost.
- If you do not show up at the scheduled start time of the tour for any reason, 100% of the tour cost will be forfeited.

#### **Motorcycle Insurance**

Full comprehensive motorcycle insurance is included in the tour fee for all motorcycle hires.

#### Security Deposit (BOND)

- At the commencement of the tour a bond of NZD\$2,500.00 is required to be held for each motorcycle rental in the event of any damage or loss to either the motorcycle, any accessories or third party property. This sum is fully refundable if the motorcycle and any accessories are returned at the conclusion of the tour without any damage, loss or expense. Any damage will be deducted from the insurance bond with the balance being refunded. The hirers maximum liability is limited to the full insurance bond plus any cost of recovery of the motorcycle. (All damages paid by credit card will incur a 2.9% credit card surcharge.)
- The bond must be taken in the form of a pre-authorisation on your Credit Card at the commencement of the tour and is held for
  the duration of your hire. Please ensure sufficient funds are available on your Credit Card for the bond pre-authorisation hold at
  the commencement of your tour. Note: Pre-Authorisation holds can only be charged to a Credit Card. Debit Cards are not valid.
- After the bond hold pre-authorisation is cancelled it may take up to 3-5 working days for the funds to be available again on your Credit Card depending on your bank.
- No transaction fees apply to Pre-Authorisation credit holds. If damage is deducted from the bond, a credit card surcharge fee of 2.9% will apply to the charged portion.
